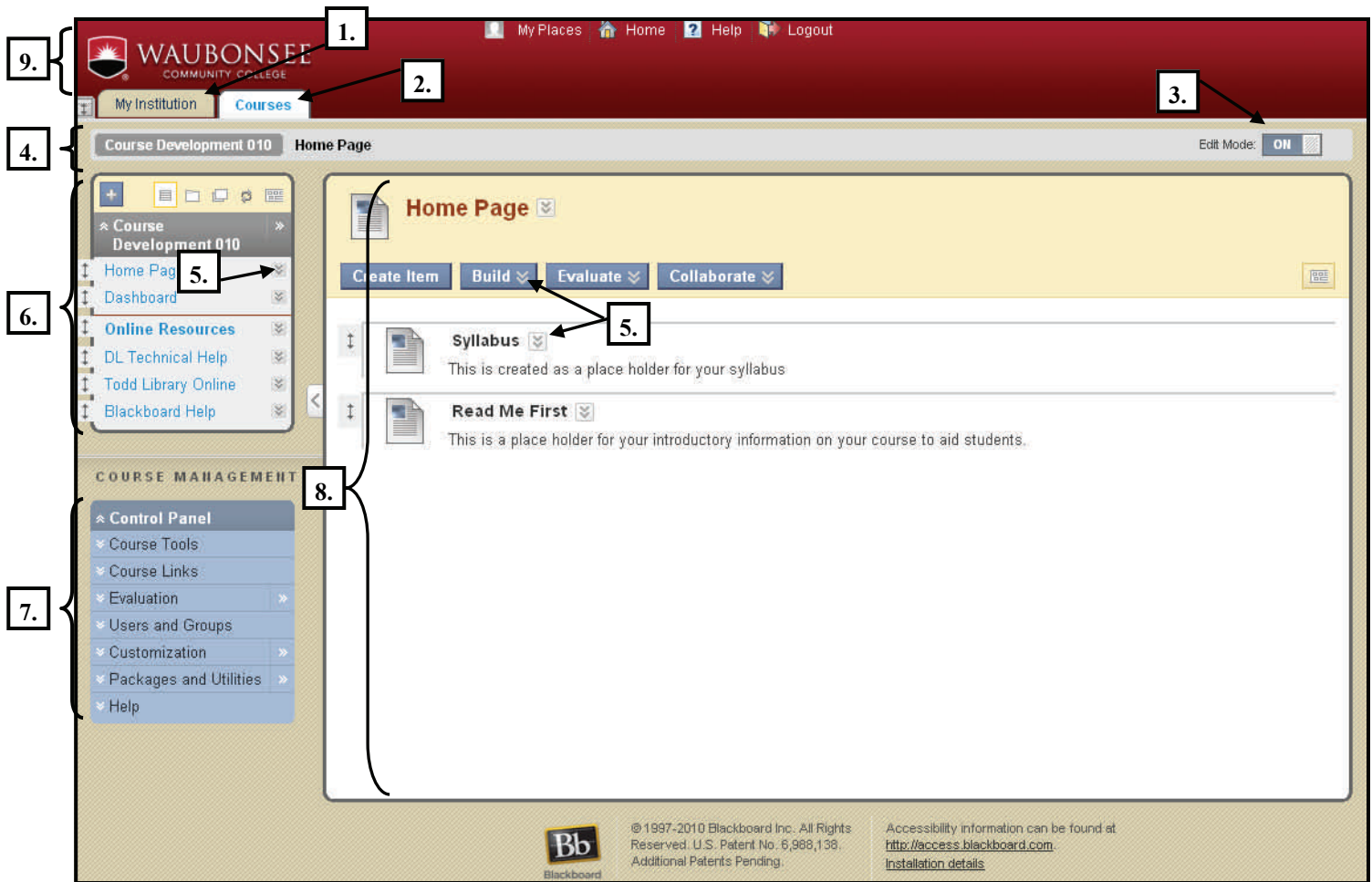

Blackboard 9 Basics

Navigation Vocabulary - Terms to Know



- 1. My Institution** - Tools and information based on a user's preferences, which includes links to courses you can access broken down by your roles and by course announcements.
- 2. Courses** - links to courses you can access broken down by your roles.
- 3. View Toggle (Edit Mode)** - Change the user view to allow editing as the instructor or view as a student.
- 4. Page Header** - Displays information about the current screen and helps to orient the user.
- 5. Action Menu (Chevron)** - Provides actions like Copy, Delete and any functions relating to the screen.
- 6. Navigation Menu (Course Menu)** - Navigation elements for the user to access specific areas in the course.
- 7. Control Panel Menu** - Course administration menu that is available to Instructors, TA's, and Graders.
- 8. Content Area** - Where you add the course content, like the syllabus, learning modules, and file folders.
- 9. Control Frame** - Contains navigation elements to access the Institution tab, Course tab, Help and Logout.
